In October 2008, an error was reported regarding the January 1973 issue VOL III, No. 2 of the Slusher Family Organization Newsletter. The error was reported by Brenda Piercy, Granddaughter of Elizabeth A. Turman.

Page 3 of that issue, in the LEFT column near the top, “6. Elizabeth A. Turman”

According to Ms. Turman’s Granddaughter, she reports:

“My grandmother was listed as "Elizabeth A. Turman.

6. Elizabeth A. Turman, my grandmother. Her name was Eliza Alice Turman . She was married in Floyd , Va. by A. J. Weddle on the 11th of September 1904. My grandfather Charles Edward Metters was working at a copper mine close to the Turman home place. After their marriage they moved to Thomasville, NC. and lived on Hwy. 109 between Thomasville and Denton NC. My grandfather's Father was from Devonshire England. That's another story! Grandmother was only married one time and I can see how the mixup with his name came about. He was always called "ED". My grandmother did not like the the name "Eliza", she thought it was a ugly name and I can remember her saying to me "I don't know why they name me "Eliza". She was always called Alice.
